## Junior Jets Closures Due to Inclement Weather

The safety of our children, their families, and staff is very important to us at Junior Jets. In the event of inclement weather, Junior Jets will follow this policy.

Generally, Junior Jets will close when the St. Vrain Valley School District (SVVSD) closes its schools with a few exceptions noted below. We will be open our normal business hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on days the SVVSD school district implements a delayed start. Junior Jets will follow these exceptions to this standard policy:

1. Junior Jets will remain open when
  1. SVVSD closes due to conditions that don't directly create safety concerns for our families or staff, such as cold temperatures only.
  2. SVVSD moves to remote or online learning days for conditions that don't directly create safety concerns for our families or staff.
2. Junior Jets will close during significant inclement weather days by vote of the Board for days that occur on holidays or other standard school closures.

The SVVSD makes every effort to provide as much advance notice as possible on school closings. It monitors forecasts and weather conditions closely and consults with county and state officials when making decisions. Decisions are usually publicized no later than 5:30 a.m. on the school day in question. As soon as possible after the SVVSD announces a decision to close its schools, we will also post a notice about the closure of Junior Jets on our Facebook page and at the top of the Events page on our website (<http://www.juniorjets.org/events.html>).

Should we ever need to close Junior Jets earlier than 6:00 p.m. due to inclement weather; we will personally notify each family regarding the need to pick up children in attendance that day. To make such decisions, we will follow the lead of the neighboring Air Route Traffic Control Center (ARTCC) and its decisions for the early dismissal of non-essential personnel. That is, when the ARTCC determines the need for an early release of its non-essential employees due to weather, Junior Jets will follow suit and close early.

Please remember that if Junior Jets remains open, but you believe that weather conditions in your specific area are not safe for your child to attend, please make the decision you feel is best for your family. If your child will not be attending as scheduled, we would appreciate a courtesy call so we can account for everyone and adjust staffing as necessary.

Full tuition is charged for any days the school is closed or closes early due to inclement weather.
